



**COMMITTEE OF ADJUSTMENT NOTICE OF DECISION  
APPLICATION NO. B-2026-003**

**TAKE NOTICE** that a decision has been made by the Committee of Adjustment for a consent to severance of property application from **John Raimondi, Applicant** on behalf of **Chris Brand, Owner**, to Section 53 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended.

The subject properties are described legally as **PLAN 51M788 LOT 6**, known municipally as **1130 Shoreview Dr**, and is zoned **“Shoreline Residential (SR)”**.

The applicant is proposing to grant a right-of-way easement over a portion of the subject lands to provide access to an adjacent property. The owner holds title to both properties. The easement area is shown on the submitted reference plan and is intended to formalize access between the two lands.

The Committee of Adjustment has considered all written and oral submissions received before and/or during the hearing as part of their decision.

- The Committee **APPROVED** the application and is satisfied that it is in keeping with Section 53 of the Planning Act, that a plan of subdivision will not be required, that the application constitutes proper and orderly development of the subject lands, and that the intent and purpose of the Official Plan and Zoning By-law have been maintained.

- The Committee **REFUSED** the application and is of the opinion the application is not in keeping with Section 53 of the Planning Act, that the application does not constitute proper and orderly development of the subject lands and that the intent and purpose of the Official Plan and Zoning By-law have not been maintained.

**NOTICE OF LAST DATE OF APPEAL**

In accordance with Section 17 (36) of the Planning Act, you may appeal to the Ontario Lands Tribunal (OLT) in respect to this decision by filing a notice of appeal with the Secretary-Treasurer either via the Ontario Land Tribunal e-file service (first-time users will need to register for a My Ontario Account) at <https://olt.gov.on.ca/e-file-service/> by selecting THE TOWN OF INNISFIL as the Approval Authority or by mail to Town of Innisfil, Secretary-Treasurer, Committee of Adjustment, 2101 Innisfil Beach Road, Innisfil, ON. L9S 1A1 no later than 4:30 p.m. on April 8, 2026. The filing of an appeal after 4:30 p.m., in person or electronically, will be deemed to have been received the next business day. The appeal fee of \$400, the current fee prescribed by the Tribunal under the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal Act, can be paid online through e-file or by certified cheque or money order made payable to the Minister of Finance, Province of Ontario. If you wish to appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal (OLT) or request a fee reduction for an appeal, forms are available from the OLT website at [www.olt.gov.on.ca](http://www.olt.gov.on.ca). 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**CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL**

After the completion of the above noted conditions, consent shall be issued by means of a Certificate of Official under Form 2 of the Planning Act.

**Planning**

1. That the approved Shoreline Permit SL-2024-005 for 1120 Shoreview Drive be revised to reflect the revised access location and tree compensation, to be reviewed to Staff's satisfaction.
2. That the Owner/Applicant retain an Ontario Land Surveyor to prepare and submit a digital copy of a reference plan of survey, to be reviewed and approved by the Town. Once approved, the survey is to be deposited on title at the Land Registry Office.
